Orenburg State Medical University is ranked among the top medical universities in Russia for pursuing MBBS and many other medical degrees. OrSMU has its own research center and holds 350+ patents under its name. It also has libraries with an aggregate collection of more than 400,000 books.

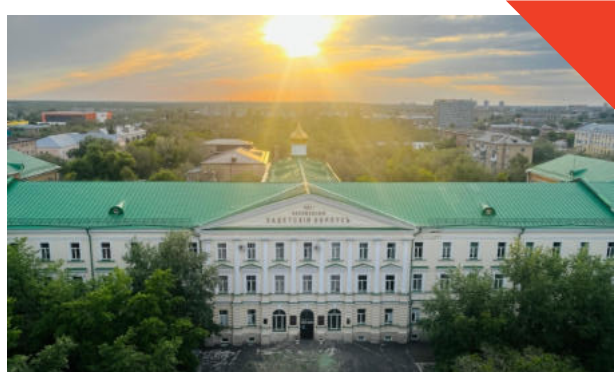
Hostel & Mess

There are three hostels of the university, opened in the years 1961, 1964 and 1981. These hostels became the second home of the students who came to study here. For the convenience of the students, the hostels are located near the main roads of the city, whereas two blocks are located within 100 meters of the university. Currently, over 900 students stay in these hostels.

The hostels are well-equipped for conducting events along with libraries, sports arenas, etc., for the students.

Hostel No. 3 is allotted for foreign students, and is located beside Academic Blocks 1 and 2 of the university. These hostels consist of flats with 4 rooms, where 2 rooms are 3-seater and the other two are 2-seater. A total of 10 students stay in each flat (section) with its own toilet and bathroom.

In 2017, the university received another 9-floor building with the help of Rus Education. It was used by many Indian students. The building is close to the biggest mall in the city and is also near the university campus.



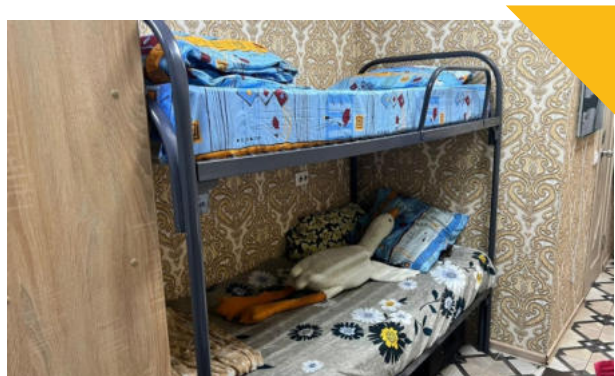

The student should obtain aggregate 50% marks in the Physics/ Chemistry/ Biology/ plus pass marks in English in unreserved category and 40% in case of the reserved category in the 12th standard.

02

The student must have qualified NEET exam in the year of admission. The validity of the NEET score for admission in MBBS abroad is for 3 years.

03

The student should be in good physical and mental health enabling the student to study.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ✓ Notarized Certificate of Secondary Education
- ✓ Notarized Certificate copy attested by Ministry of Human Resource Development
- ✓ Notary attested copy of birth certificate.
- ✓ Medical certificate with all necessary laboratory test results including AIDS test.
- ✓ Copy of national Passport with minimum 9 months validity.
- ✓ 12 recent passport-sized photographs in matt paper only

HOW TO APPLY?

Step 1 - Fill up the admission form for your MBBS program and submit the required documents.

Step 2 - Students will get the admission/invitation letter from the university.

Step 3 - Apply for visa and provide the original passport and other supporting documents.

Step 4 - Pay your tuition fees. Students can also avail education loan if required.

Step 5 - Prepare your bags for your travel to Russia.

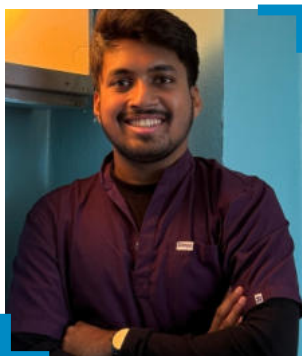
Step 6 - Embark on your journey to Russia and commence your MBBS studies there.

DEAD SEA IN THE DESERT. In the spring of 1906, a small river overflowed for several kilometres and flooded the salt mines while forming salt lakes.

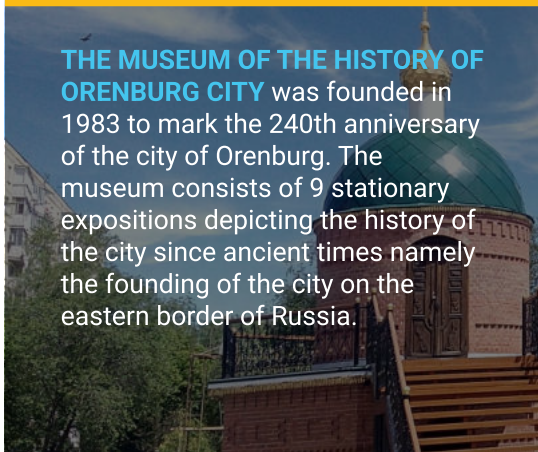


CARAVANSERAI
